SUMMARY OF CHANGES

Deleted reference to CAWG Administrative Procedures Guide.

Deleted 18.d which referenced the authority to award distress Saves and Finds to the Director of Operations.

CAPR 39-3, 28 December 2012, is supplemented as follows:

SECTION F – ACTIVITY AND SERVICE RIBBONS

18. Authority to Award Ribbons.

c. **Added.** The authority to award the following activity and service ribbons is delegated to the several California Wing group commanders for personnel attached to their group headquarters and for personnel assigned to squadrons attached to their groups.

- (1) Red Service Ribbon and clasps.
- (2) Air Search and Rescue Ribbon, clasps and propeller device.
- (3) Search Find Ribbon, clasps and propeller device (Non-Distress). Eligible participants are recommended for this award by the Incident Commander for the mission.
- (4) Community Service Ribbon and clasps.
- (5) Cadet Orientation Pilot Ribbon and clasps.
- (6) Command Service Ribbon (for Squadron).
- (7) Counterdrug Ribbon and clasps
- (8) Homeland Security Ribbon and clasps.
